- Logic is not universal; rhetoric is not universal either.
- Expected sequence of thought in English is essentially a Platonic-Artistotelian sequence.
- About 600 foreign students' compositions from 3 basic language groups were analyzed.




Diagram 3: Japanese Organization

- In sentences
- For no reader
- Without structure

- For 'self-discussion'
- For linking different ideas
- Developing the writing habit
- Thinking through ideas
- Doing the first draft
- Getting initial thoughts
- Generating ideas
- 'Ventilating' feelings and ideas
- Summarizing knowledge
- To stop procrastinating
